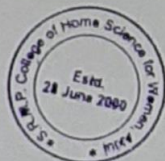

Result of LOI will be communicated to institute by NAAC within 15 days.

Institute has to submit SSR within 2 weeks of acceptance of LOI by NAAC.

NAAC will decide dates of visits after receipt of SSR i.e in 3 weeks.

NAAC visit will complete within one month

NAAC new grading system and newly added other procedures related to the accreditation and assessment were discussed and brought in notice of IQAC members.

IQAC members were informed about each and every aspect of 2nd cycle of assessment and accreditation and given instruction to take further necessary action for 2nd cycle of NAAC assessment and accreditation.

AQAR filled by IQAC for academic year 2012-13, 2013-14,2014-15 and AQAR to be filled for academic year 2015-16 will be kept for reviewing for completion of criterion and files and also for the preparation of SSR.

Tournament was organised for two consecutive days and all the participants played overwhelmingly in all the five events. Tough competition was seen to achieve the General Championship in Athletics events.






General Championship of Athletics was won by C.B. Shah College, Sangli. B.C.A. College Satara got second place and host college stood third.
