1. Annual planning was prepared by each department and implemented as per schedule for academic year 2020-2021. Action taken reports were prepared by concerned department. Various students centric activities were conducted viz. co-curricular, extracurricular, community reach programmes in online mode due to pandemic situation which enabled students to gain subject related knowledge, enhanced their skills and helped in overall development of student.
2. AQAR for Academic year 2019-2020 was filled in online format and submitted to NAAC on 08.04.2021.
3. Summary reports of all departments and committees were prepared by concerned departments and committees.
4. Strategies were planned by institute for improving admission to various programmes and courses such as advertisement through banner displays , online admission campaigning, pamphlet distribution in online and offline mode etc.
5. To make more ICT enabled teaching and learning process staff and students were encouraged to adopt more ICT based teaching and learning techniques. ICT enabled teaching learning processes were used through LMS i.e Google classroom and Google sites. Google classrooms were created and used by six staff members for various courses taught in F.Y., S.Y., and T.Y. \$PM App developed by Parent institute was used by seven staff members for teaching student according to their pace through uploading videos. Staff also used online platform such as Google meet and Zoom for teaching student various topics and solving their doubts.

Students were encouraged to take specific projects, presentations and assignments which enable them to use more ICT. Students were given specific projects, presentations, assignments which enabled them to use more ICT viz. R.A, Internship, Practical presentation and Assignments. Faculties of institute were encouraged to attend Faculty development programmes and webinars related to teaching, learning and evaluation process.

The workshop was arranged in order to understand the printing style of Rajasthan.





The main objective of workshop was to make the blocks at home using cardboard.

Actual Dabu printing was demonstrated after preparation of blocks with acrylic colours.


Total 40 students of S.Y. B.Sc. And T.Y. B.Sc. Participated in the workshop.



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
Orientation programme on quality issues for teachers and students





Online workshop on SWAYAM & IAS Aplya Dari and Udyojak Aplya Bhetila

On 19 June 2021, On the occasion of Reading Day , webinar was organized by the Library of college.





The topic of webinar was “Importance of Reading Texts at present.”
