On 23-08-2017 the short films on swaccha Bharat were presented for the NSS volunteers.



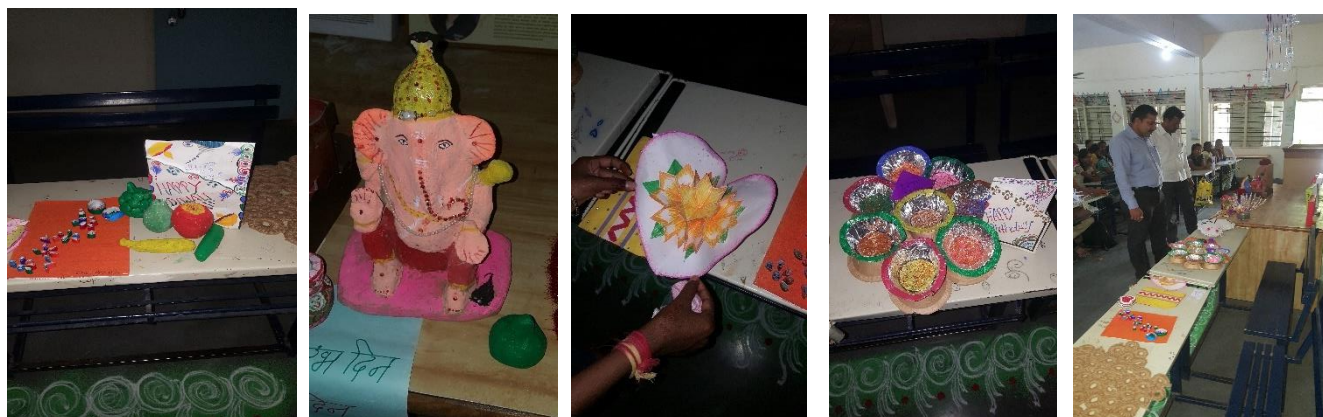
## Speech Competition:
