Online campaigning was done with the help of a Questionnaire on Covid-19, Corona infection and safety measures to avoid it.


This campaigning included Google form questionnaire. It was circulated to all the students, staff and others who were there in various Whatsapp groups.




#### 30 September, 2020

40 students from S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc. participated in the workshop.


The workshop was arranged to create awareness about folk paintings of Bihar. To use this such kind of painting on garments and articles like face mask to enhance the beauty and quality of the product.












# Madhubani design on mask




#### **Calendar Making Workshop**




Date: 21-22.12.2020




### SCIENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS




### **Workshop on Handwork**




### **Workshop on Warli Painting**


### **World No Tobacco Day Programme**

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
